Dear Parents,

I am delighted to say our attendance yesterday was 98 % so thank you to everyone for sending your children back to school. It is lovely to see all their smiling faces and the atmosphere around school is extremely positive.

I am also pleased to report that our new staggered breaks and lunchtimes went smoothly and your children all cooperated so well and adapted to the changes with confidence.

I have spoken to the security guards and the CST as we have to ensure both safety around Covid-19 and also general security and do not want to have people queueing on the streets outside the gates. Please can I ask that parents only arrive just in time for their allocated drop off slots. If you have children in Year 5 or 6 you might consider dropping them off at the top of Eaton Rd and letting them walk onto the campus themselves. If you arrive early, please wait in your cars until just before the correct time for your child to go in. Please remember the slots are allocated by surname alphabetically so A-F at 8.45am, G-M at 8.55am and N-Z at 9.05am.

The security guards on the Eaton Rd gate will guide parents and children to walk around the back of the High School building to alleviate congestion with the High School pupils, particularly around 8.45-9am.

At the end of the school day, the teachers and teaching assistants of Key Stage 2 will bring the children to their designated zones to meet you. A-F at 3.15pm, G-M at 3.25pm and N-Z at 3.35pm. Please arrive promptly so the staff members are not left waiting with your child for you and then please leave the campus as quickly as possible. If you feel comfortable, you could arrange to meet your Y5 and 6 children off campus, either on Eaton Rd or at your car in the street nearby. If this is the arrangement you would like to make, please email your child's class teacher to inform them.

As you can imagine, organising these new arrangements has been quite a challenge and I am grateful to my teachers and teaching assistants for their extra efforts in collecting and delivering the children from their new zones. Please remember to keep a social distance from other adults and I would encourage you to wear a mask for your own protection and the safety of others.

It would be really helpful if any members of the parent body would be interested in volunteering as "Covid Stewards", to assist me in ensuring the parents and pupils arrive and leave safely at their allotted times.
